As the following table shows, utilizing the American Community Survey (ACS) data from the 2006-2010 vintage which would be used in the 2011 redistricting, there was no district which was 50% or more of any single Citizen Voting Age Population (CVAP) ethnic/racial subset.

Population Growth and Current Deviations

The US Census has released in a “legacy format” the data from the decennial census, identifying the whole count of persons and where they resided as of April 1, 2020. Redistricting Partners has concluded the work of placing this data into the census blocks, block groups, and tracts.¹

¹ These counts are based on the 2020 Census geography. There may be slight differences as many census blocks were consolidated.

This data represents the whole population data prior to a state required reallocation of prison population that will be conducted by the Statewide Database at UC Berkeley. This adjusted data will be completed in the coming weeks and updated counts will be provided at that time.

Based on this data, the city has grown by 12,015 residents, or 10.7%, since the last decennial census. This is significantly higher than the state population change of 6.1%.

District 7 saw the largest increase of residents with 2,553, and the district with the slowest growth was District 6, which gained 681 residents. All eight city council districts experienced a growth in population.

With a total population of 124,300, the ideal population for any district would be 15,538. The seat with the largest population is District 7 at 16,632 (+7%) and the smallest is District 6 at 14,622 (-5.9%), giving the city a total of 12.9% deviation, slightly outside of the 10% deviation range.

The Citizen Voting Age Population has grown at almost the same pace as the city's total population. Based on CVAP, the city's adult eligible voter population has grown by 11.4%.

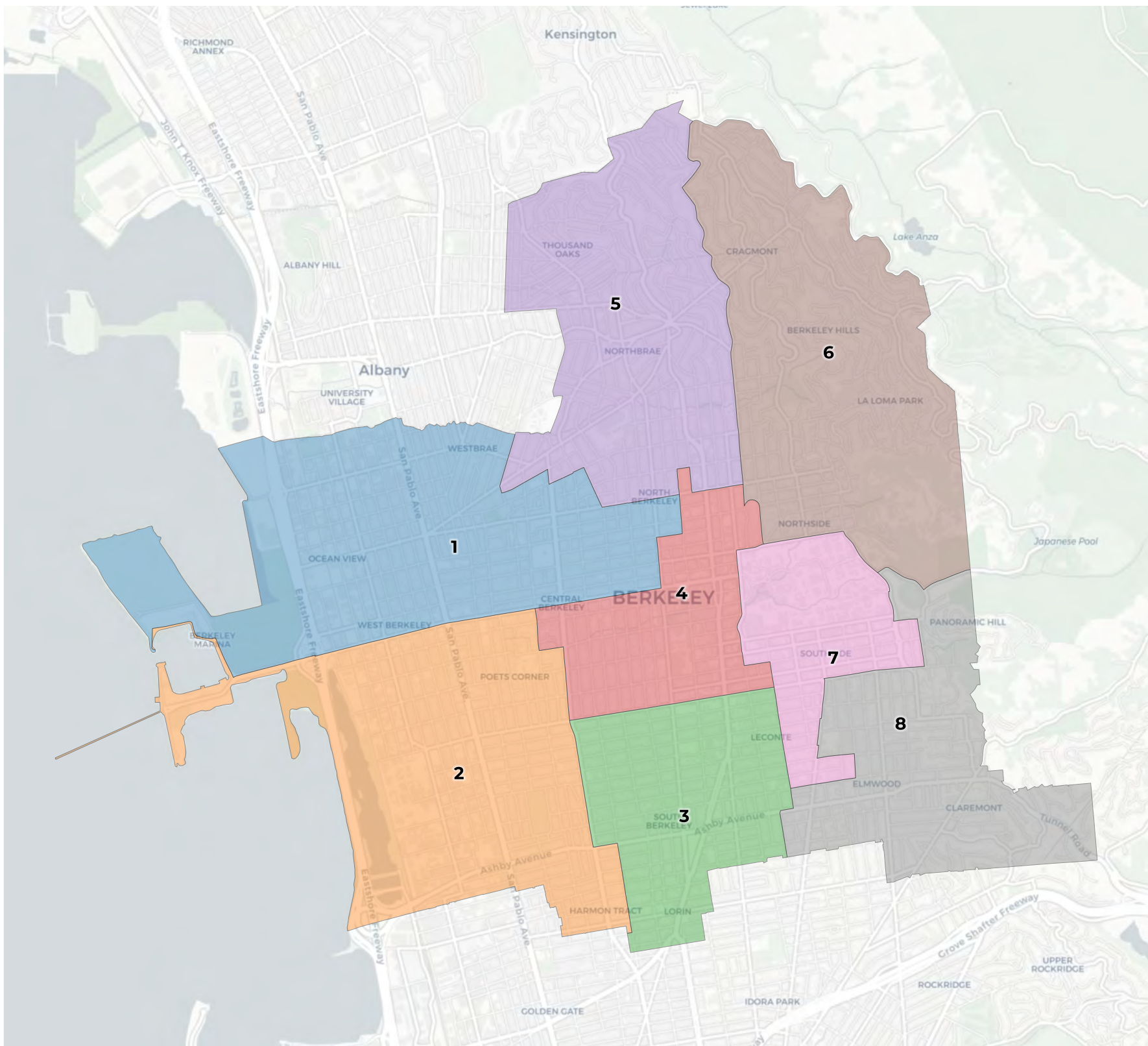
These data, and the Ethnic and Racial subgroups utilized for Voting Rights Act calculations, have been finalized for the current redistricting cycle. It shows significant change in the ethnic composition of districts since the prior redistricting. Overall, CVAP growth was 34.1% among Latinos, 0.5% growth among Asians, and there was a negative growth rate of 6.9% among African Americans. Some notable ethnic and racial CVAP changes include an over 30% negative growth rate for African Americans in District 3 and a double-digit growth rate for Latinos in all but two districts.
